

## Rungus Vowel Phonemes

	Unrounded	Rounded
High:	i	u
Low:	a	o

The phoneme /i/ has two allophones: [i] when standing alone, at the beginning of a word or at the end of a word. The allophone [ɪ] appears in the middle of a word.

Semivowels:

y, w

Note: Vowel length is used to indicate a merging of two vowels with a glottal stop in between.

/rītan/ vowel /i/ is long; for ra'it when an /-an/ is added to change focus.
